

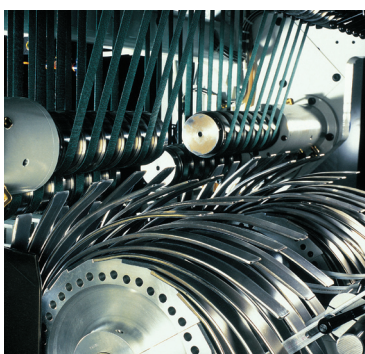
## Restoration of component performance

### Folder inspection as preventive maintenance.

Folder inspection is running time-related maintenance whereby our experience has shown that with commercial web presses it is advisable to carry this out after every 180 million revolutions. With newspaper presses this should be done after every four to five years (depending on press utilization).

Systematic inspection of the folder of your press assures early detection of wear and possible defects.

We use check lists to examine the moving components in the collect cylinder and jaw cylinder and provide a detailed report for scheduling any further maintenance work needed. ■■
